EMBL-wide context

Public engagement is part of the 2022 - 2026 EMBL programme.

EMBL's Science Education and Public Engagement office (SEPE), formerly European Learning Laboratory for the Life Sciences (ELLS) has been established to strategically support the embedding of public engagement across EMBL.
